The classroom teacher is at the centre of your child's learning team and is supported by a school learning team. Based on classroom needs, each kindergarten program will also be supported by a multidisciplinary team that works with large and small groups in the classroom.

Speech-Language Pathologists (SLPs)

### **English Language Learners**











- Approximately 25% of students in the CBE are English Language learners. At Connaught School we have just over 65% of students identified as ELL.
- Language instruction is systematic, targeted and explicit while providing appropriate scaffolds to develop strong English Language proficiency specific to each student's needs.
- Teachers use the Alberta English Proficiency Benchmarks to formatively assess students and inform programing decisions.



### Getting Ready for Kindergarten











- dress themselves (zippers, buttons, put on/off shoes)
- use the bathroom and wash their hands on their own
- put away toys and help out in other small ways at home
- practice opening and closing snack containers, using a water bottle, put items of different sizes in their backpack
- play games, take turns, compromise, begin to problem solve
- develop a consistent bedtime routine



## Getting Ready for Kindergarten






### Take time to talk with your child about everyday activities:



- share special activities together, such as walks to the park
- talk about what you are seeing and doing
- talk, read, sing and play in your first language every day
- praise children for their efforts and courage to overcome setbacks



talk about how it is okay to make mistakes



## Getting Ready for Kindergarten









### Read to your child every day:

- •read stories together in *your first language* to help your child develop vocabulary, listening and speaking skills
- •enjoy reading different types of books: picture books, information books, nursery rhymes, poetry
- •encourage your child to talk about the pictures and stories as you read together
- visit your community library









### **School Hours**

We offer morning (AM) and afternoon (PM) kindergarten classes. The times are:

- Morning (AM) Kindergarten Hours: 8:00am 10:52am (drop off from 7:50am – 8:00am)
- Afternoon (PM) Kindergarten Hours: 11:40am 2:32pm (drop off from 11:30am – 11:40am)

Please be on time to drop off and pick up your child

### **Student Attendance**

Parents are asked to telephone the school at 403 777 8560 (extension 1) if their child will be late or absent. The attendance line is available 24 hours a day. Office staff contact parents whose children are absent without prior notice.














## Kindergarten Arrival & Dismissal







### **Arrival**

- Non-bussed students meet staff member just outside the kindergarten door with their parent / caregiver
- Bussed students are met by bus supervisor at the designated school bus zone

### **Dismissal**

- Non-bussed students meet their parent / caregiver just outside the kindergarten door
- Bussed students meet the bus supervisor in the school and go together to the designated school bus zone










What does my child need for school?


**Indoor shoes** (will stay at the school) We ask that children have velcro fastened shoes until your child is able to independently tie shoe laces.





**Backpack** (large to transport a big library book, snack bag)















What does my child need for school?

One small healthy snack in a bag or box









- Reusable water bottle
- Extra clothing is optional (underwear, pants)
- Children should be dressed appropriately for the weather
- School supplies are provided by the school (such as paper, colouring pencils, scissors, glue, etc.)

## Transportation | Bussing







### **Getting Students to School**

- If you live in the bus zone, you can register your child for yellow school bus transportation online using your <a href="MyCBE/PowerSchool">MyCBE/PowerSchool</a> or completing a transportation registration form.
- Please visit the <u>CBE website to find more</u> <u>information on fees and service levels</u> for the 2023-24 school year.
- To be included in the yellow school bus route planning for September, parents must register by the June 16 deadline.

### **Conditional Riders**

Students who are in the walk zone can apply to be a conditional rider. Conditional riders are accepted based on space on the bus and address.

### How do I know if my child can ride the bus?



Please register using your MyCBE Powerschool account to view bussing information. Families of kindergarten students are asked to meet their child at the door of the bus to ensure their safety. Note: there is no mid-day bus. Your child could only ride it to OR from school. The bussing fees are \$130.
